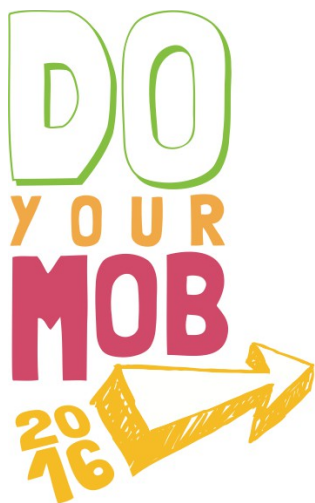

The international competences: tools and techniques of valorisation

The international dimension is an essential part of the vocational education and training (EU Strategy 2020, Green Paper of 2009). Europe is nowadays invested by changes, which require international competences also to students of the IVET pathways. There are many ways to promote the development of these competences, but it is necessary that these are defined, integrated and encouraged within a curriculum to let them produce the desired results. The need of a strategic vision of internationalization is fundamental to produce a best practice and favour in trainees the acquisition of international competences as PRODUCTIVITY (the union of efficiency, analytic ability, problem solving, and credibility), RESILIENCE (ability to adapt to a different situation, knowledge of own weak and strong points, being confident and tenacious), and finally, CURIOSITY (tolerance, interest in new things, ability to cooperate and networking). These are examples of competences connected with strategies and activities of internationalization.

On the basis of the results of the research "Hidden Competences" published by the Centre for International Mobility of Helsinki (2013), of the results of the initiative GORES (to be published in October 2016) finalized to the valorisation of learning outcomes in learning mobilities, of the interest of the European politics for internationalization of apprenticeships and of the training in alternance (Erasmus Pro), and finally of the tendency of most part of the recent European project development in the VET area to internationalize learning pathways and to engineer solutions of double recognition of the IVET qualifications, DoYourMOB 2016 promote an idea of transnational mobility as part of a wider process of internationalization, which targets:

- people (students and professionals of the VET field);
- the systems (organizations which have to develop new assets and implement human resources dedicated to the management of alternative solutions of learning - as the learning mobility).

In order to face the requests of the labour market the VET system has to be provided of tools aimed to the valorisation of "hidden competences" of our youths, and in particular, of those competences which can be easily acquired with transnational experiences of learning.

An analysis of the impact of the transnational mobility on the capability of young people to transit the labour market underlines that this capability is still weakly supported by an aware valorisation of the transnational experience, reducing it to mere linguistic and "cultural" learning.

The here proposed work conference wants to provide institutional dates on this field, and on the other hand, present solutions to valorize competences, which are still "hidden" and not recognizable by the labour market.

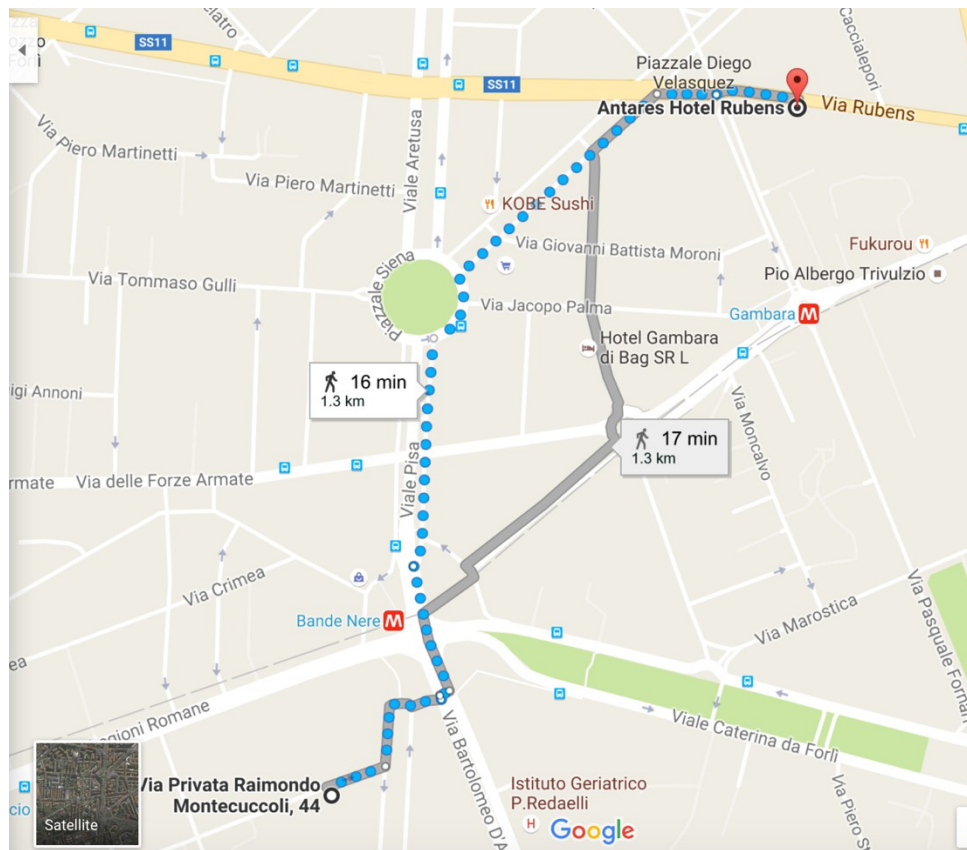
